# Transit Visa Application



#### Who can you include in your application?

You can use this form to apply for a visa for a single person or for a family. A family may include a principal applicant, partner, and dependent children under 20.

#### What should you send with your application?

You must send the passport (the original document) of each person included in the application with your completed and signed form. You must also provide two passport-size photographs of each person, evidence of your travel arrangements, and a statement of the purpose of your visit to your destination country.

When you have completed the form, please use the checklist at the end to make sure you have sent all the documents and information we need.

We will process your application only when we receive all the information and documents we need. If you do not send all the required information, we will return your application.

#### **Group transit visas**

If you are a Chinese national and you will be transiting New Zealand with a group of Chinese nationals, you may apply for a group transit visa. As well as completing this form and providing the information listed above, your tour organiser or agent will need to complete the form *Group Transit Application (INZ 1155)* on behalf of the group. These group visa applications should be lodged at either our office in Beijing or our office in Shanghai.

#### Where do you send your application?

If you are applying for a group transit visa, see above. For individual applications, send your application to your nearest Immigration New Zealand office.





The information we collect may also be used to determine whether you are allowed to board a flight to New Zealand. We will not share your personal information with airline check-in agents; however, we will send a boarding message to the airline check-in agent based on the information you have provided in this form.

Immigration New Zealand may also share the information you have provided with other government agencies that are entitled to it by law, or with other agencies.

If you come to New Zealand, you will be able to ask to see the information we hold about you and have any of it corrected if you think it is necessary.
